CFCE and the District met on November 15, 2018 for a half-day session. The following is a brief summary.

Classified Senate MOU

District provided counter proposal #6 for an MOU with the Classified Senate.

CFCE will be working with the Classified Senate leadership prior to putting together a counter proposal.

Reclassification MOU

The District provided CFCE with an MOU for the 2018-19 reclassification process. The District is proposing to suspend the reclass process for the 2018-19 year. In lieu of the reclass process, McKnight & Associates Inc. will review the current 2018-19 application materials and make recommendations to the Vice Chancellor of HR by March 29, 2019. Also, included in the MOU are the timelines for appealing the decision. In addition, reclass applicants whose appeals were denied in 2017/18 may be included in the 2018/19 review by MK & Association Inc., if applicants re-submit a packet.
