1 Memorandum of Understanding 2 Between 3 Coast Community College District and 4 Coast Federation of Educators/American Federation of Teachers, Local 1911 5 6 August 23, 2018 7 8 The following Memorandum of Understanding entered into by and between the Coast Community 9 College District ("District") and the Coast Federation of Educators/American Federation of Teachers ("CFE/AFT"), is expressly made pursuant to the Education Employment Relations Act 10 11 and the current Collective Bargaining Agreement ("Agreement"). 12 13 ARTICLE XX. EMPLOYEE AND DEPENDENT BENEFITS COVERAGE 14 15 The parties agree that the following language shall be added to Article XX, Section 20.6.c.1.d of 16 the 2018-2020 Agreement: 17 18 Section 20.6.c.1.d: For employees who retire on or after July 1, 2019, and are age 65 or older, 19 and whose spouse or allowable dependent is younger than the retiree, the spouse or allowable 20 dependent must enroll in the same plan family as the retiree (e.g. the District's United Health 21 Care HMO or Kaiser HMO plan) in order to remain eligible for the continuation of benefits. 22 Upon reaching age 65, the spouse or eligible dependent must enroll in the same plan as the 23 retiree {e.g. United Health Care Medicare Advantage PPO or Kaiser Senior Advantage HMO) and all available Medicare related programs as required by the District in order to remain eligible 24 25 for the continuation of benefits. 26 27 For employees who retire on or after July 1, 2019, and are age 65 or older, and whose spouse or 28 allowable dependent is younger than the retiree and living out of state, that spouse or allowable dependent shall be permitted to enroll in/remain on the District self-funded Delta Health Systems 29 30 PPO, until such time as the spouse or allowable dependent reaches age 65, at which time the 31 spouse or allowable dependent must enroll in the same plan as the retiree (United Health Care 32 Medicare Advantage PPO) and all available Medicare related programs as required by the 33 District in order to remain eligible for the continuation of benefits. 34 35 Rob Schneiderman, Chief Negotiator/Date 36 37 38 Mary L.
