Scholarship Eligibility

- Must be a CFCE member or legal dependent of a CFCE member. CFCE member must be in good standing for at least one year prior to the application submission date, which is no later than April 14, 2022.
- Applicant must have attended the previous semester, be currently attending or planning to attend a community college, four-year college/university, or technical/trade school
- Scholarship recipient will be required to show proof of enrollment within 6 months of being awarded in order to receive check.
- Previous scholarship recipients must wait 2 years before being able to reapply (ex: if a recipient is awarded for Spring 2021 they cannot reapply till Spring 2023)

A scholarship committee comprised of three (3) to five (5) Executive Council members will review scholarship applications and rate each applicant's personal statement written in essay format using the rating criteria on the reverse side. For a fair and unbiased rating of each essay, applicant names are removed prior to distribution of essays to the committee. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to refrain from awarding a scholarship if submissions do not meet reasonable standards. The Scholarship Committee may determine if a second scholarship within the scholarship period is merited.
